



SOS TIKUNAS CAMPAIGN. YOU CAN CONTRIBUTE! HELP THEM!

As of the beginning of May, KAMURI has been coordinating the SOS Tikunas campaign.

SOS TIKUNAS has been supporting the Tikuna and Kokama communities of the Upper Rio Solimões (Amazonas) in the form of resources for making over six thousand individual protection masks (including payment of the work for people in local communities), hygiene and cleaning products, and food products.

In addition to Kamuri members, involved in conducting the campaign are some teachers at the Language Studies' Institute, of State University of Campinas (UNICAMP), also at UFAM (Federal University of Amazonas), UEA (State University of Amazonas), IFAM (Federal Institute of Amazonas)), and of the Tabatinga municipal education system, DSEI-SESAL, and Tikunas communities.

The SOS Tikunas Campaign continues, mainly because health conditions in the country side of Amazonas are quite precarious for an exceptional situation, such as that of the Coronavirus pandemic; there are no enough intensive care units in the entire state.

The State of Amazonas, with 1,571,000 km², is larger, in extension, than any country in South America, except Argentina. Its area is larger than that of most European countries: 2.5 times the size of France; 3 times the size of Spain; 4 times the size of Norway; 4.5 times that of Germany; 5 times that of Italy, and so on.

Only the brazilian municipalities in which the lands of Tikuna communities are located (Tabatinga, Benjamin Constant, São Paulo de Olivença, Santo Antonio do Içá, Jutai, Tonantins and Amaturá) add up to an area of more than 125 thousand km² (almost the size of Greece; a larger extension than Bulgaria, Hungary, Austria, Portugal, among other European countries).
